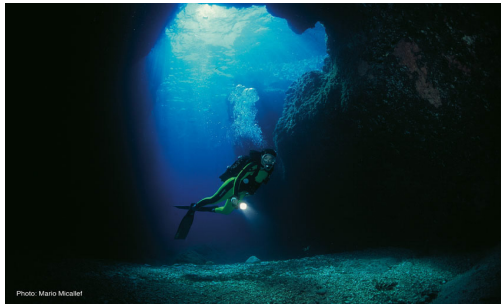


## Malta, Comino & Gozo Trip May 7<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> 2009

This year we go back to one of our favourite dive destinations, Malta. We dive with Maltaqua, one of the largest and oldest dive centres on the Island. Simone, Anna and Agnes run the schedule like clockwork and we are always treated brilliantly by the entire operation.

We will again be staying at Sands which are Maltaqua's purpose built self catering apartments. These are fairly basic apartments but they are very close to the dive centre and a short walk to the bars and restaurants in the lively Buggiba.



The trip to Malta this year will cost €475. This price does not include Flights or food for the duration of the stay. It does include all transfers from and to airport and dive sites, accommodation based on two people sharing and 10 escorted dives including a day diving from a boat at the Comino caves and also a day trip to dive the best sites on Gozo. 1 night dive is also included. The price includes air but not nitrox.

In order to dive Malta comfortably you must have:

- a) Experience of diving below 20m
- b) Around 20 dives done although we will consider less
